Pastor's Pause: "God's Love"

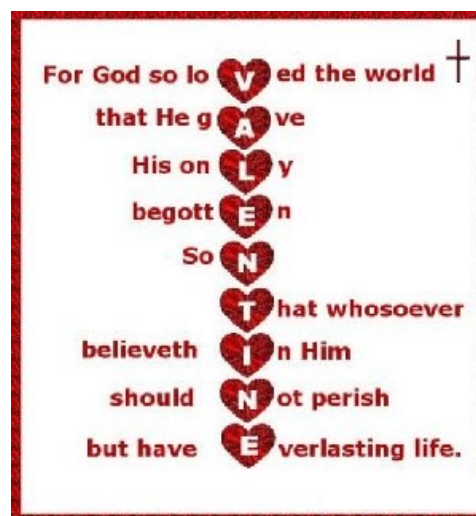
For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. - John 3:16 NLT

Are you familiar with some of the contributions of African-Americans to the Methodist movement?

Harry Hosier and Richard Allen played an important role in the beginnings of the Methodist church.

Jarena Lee was the first African-American woman to preach at the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

Bishop Leontine Kelly was the first African-American woman elected as Bishop in the UMC in 1984.

Rev. Charlotte Nichols was one of two African-American women elected to serve as district superintendents in the UMC in 1990. (Some of you may be familiar with Rev. Nichols, a retired member of the Peninsula-Delaware Conference, who served as the Easton District superintendent (1990-1996).
